# Christian Youth In Action 2019

God blessed us once again with more than 100 students (23 from Western Maine) who studied God's Word and went out to share it with children. During the Commissioning Service the students repeated this year's Scripture, Romans 1:1-17, which both staff and students memorized. Director John Romano taught from this Scripture each day in chapel.



The young people were assigned to teams of 4 members with an adult supervisor who worked with the team to help each young person grow in their understanding and ability to share the Gospel. The whole student body went out to do Open Air ministry. About half the student body canvassed the Livermore Falls and Jay area with Gospel literature, while those in the regular program taught 4 Day Clubs.



**4 Day Clubs June 24-27** were held in 12 different locations. Some were outdoors in parks and backyards, some in churches and homes.

Children gathered in parks with games and sat down to listen to a full club program of an hour.

The clubs were done in partnership with 7 Western Maine churches where the children will have continuing opportunity to learn from God's Word. We are so grateful for the work done by the hosts of each club location for inviting the children.



There were 131 children enrolled in the clubs. 5 boys and girls professed to trust Jesus as their Savior.

We are thankful for our supervisors who tutored the WME young people doing the clubs. They go with them to all their classes, listen to them practice, drive them to their assigned ministries and give them constant encouragement. Without the supervisors CYIA could not be done...
