

# With the Wisemen we too worship Him.

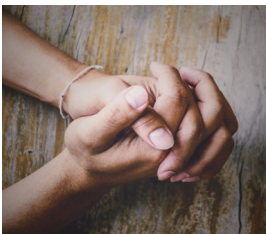


You should have seen the faces of the children who listened wide-eyed in the Chapel during fair season.
