# Club Ministry @ The Neighborhood House

We just wrapped up our 2022-2023 school year clubs! Over the last few months of club we focused on teaching the elementary and middle school children about being fearfully and wonderfully made by a God who loves and knows them (Psalm 139). These may seem like basic truths to many of us but for many of these children this truth is not familiar to them. Their reactions to this important truth, about being valuable to God and being loved and created by Him for a purpose, have been very telling of the contrary message they are receiving from the world around them.





Along with Psalm 139, we incorporated teaching about respect and kindness, for themselves and for others. Throughout each club meeting there have been many spontaneous teaching moments as we sit around the table for a meal, participate in game time, or even on the van rides to and from club. These moments have allowed opportunity for the children to think about their actions, or words, and whether they were an example of kindness and respect. One week on the van ride home two of the children were not being kind to each other. Another child spoke up and asked them if they remembered the memory verse from club. He then began reciting Ephesians 4:32. Seeds of truth from God's Word being planted and applied!

Several of our staff and volunteers have shared stories of their testimonies with them as a way to help others open up and encourage discussion. Many of these youth will begin high school in the Fall which creates a need to have a middle school and a high school club. Our Middle School group needed (and still needs!) lots of prayer. Specifically, we've been praying for guidance for a teen boy who struggles at our club, wondering how to reach him.
