Among that Jesus used you all as well to help fill other needs around camp. The new pool deck project was fully funded, the new-to-us maintenance truck purchase was fully funded. We were given a new dock system for our canoe dock and even given a 4-wheeler for our program director, Jerry Said. All these gifts were given by God through His people. Thank you.

Summer was full of children running around the grounds, and each day as I sat on the porch of the craft house watching them, I was in awe of what the Lord was doing. This was my first summer as Camp Director. It was a great summer. All the children heard that they were loved by our creator God, and that He died for their sins—the things they did wrong. They had times to play and have fun; to see the laughter on their faces was amazing. But there were times they had tears, when they were homesick, when they missed home. For those children who do not have a good home life, they had tears of joy, because they finally found someone who loved them—Jesus.

I want to thank each of you for praying for us and for giving financially so children can hear the Gospel. Without Jesus, we are nothing. We are everything because of Him and what He has done.
